## PROJECT HOMECOMING

Project Homecoming began in the aftermath of Hurricane Katrina as a ministry of the Presbytery of South Louisiana, with support from Presbyterian Disaster Assistance. Though it still maintains an affiliation with the Presbytery, Project Homecoming is now operating as a separate faith based non-profit that continues to rebuild homes and communities impacted by Hurricane Katrina.

Utilizing volunteer labor and experienced construction staff, Project Homecoming rebuilds homes and communities impacted by Hurricane Katrina.

Since its start in April 2007, Project Homecoming has led over 10,000 volunteers in the rebuilding of 150 homes of low-income households.

Project Homecoming has hosted adult, college, and youth mission teams from all over the world, and now we are excited to have you serve with us as well.

## FAQ's

Q: What is included in the week?

A: All meals, work projects, supervision, tools, materials and activities are included in the total price of the trip. We set up meaningful projects and make sure you have the resources you need to complete the work.

Q: Do we plan our own programming for the week?

A: Trust us with the programming! Our staff is dedicated to the spiritual development that takes place through mission work. We have developed a program of work, recreation, and spiritual reflection that will center around the mission here in New Orleans. Time is allotted for individual, large group, and church group time to help facilitate discussion.

A: Work projects will range from light construction to community projects like planting community gardens and painting schools. Projects will be age and skill appropriate. All project teams will have a Project Homecoming staff member working with them to ensure safety, effectiveness, and fun!
